Dinner Crew Position:

We are searching for compassionate and friendly volunteers to support our Summer of Hope program's family-style dining segment. These volunteers will **prepare meals for our youth for our breakfast and lunch times and manage clean-up after each.** The volunteer kitchen crew position requires availability Monday through Friday between 9:30 am - 11:30 am. You do not need to be available every day of program, but you will need to be available for said time slot on your days of availability.

To ensure success as a volunteer kitchen-crew member, you should exhibit an interest in preparing meals and interacting with youth. Meals will be balanced and simple, so you do not need to be a chef, but you should have a desire to work in the kitchen and share laughs and wisdom with youth. Ultimately, a superb volunteer kitchen-crew member will be dedicated to making sure our youth receive healthy meals.

Tasks:

- Prepare meals; could be as simple as warming up food or light cooking
- Organize table settings for youth and volunteers
- Present meals (with family-style, meals will be placed in larger serving dishes)
- Engage in discussions with youth and modeling appropriate behaviors/methods in the kitchen and at the dinner table.
